ACADEMIC POLICY 27

GRADE POINT AVERAGE FOR ASSOCIATE AND BACCALAUREATE DEGREES

27.1. General

1.1. Scope Policy regarding grade point average required for associate and baccalaureate degrees.

1.2. Authority W. Va. Code §§ 18B-2A-4, 18B-1-6, and the Higher Education Policy Commission's Procedural Rule entitled Grade Point Average for Associate and Baccalaureate Degrees 133 C.S.R.22.

1.3. Effective Date – August 16, 2023

1.4. Revision of Former Policy Repeals and replaces Glensville State University Board of Governors Policy 27 Grade Point Average for Associate and Baccalaureate Degrees [2006][2018][2020].

27.2 Definitions

2.1 "Graduation Requirements" refer to all requirements for graduation as outlined in the catalog under General Requirements for Degrees.

2.2 "Registered" refer to all courses at the undergraduate level attempted at any institution.

27.3. Grade Point Average Required for Graduation

3.1. Quality points are based on the following point values for each semester hour of credit: "A" 4, "B" 3; "C" 2; "D" 1 and "F" 0. The grade point average to be computed for graduation purposes (not necessarily each
